One of only 12 legendary Charles Banks designed courses in the world, the 6,175-yard, par 69 course sits among the 100-year old pines of Linkhorn Bay in the beautiful Birdneck Point neighborhood of Virginia Beach. A challenge to players of all levels, the course offers a unique finish to any round.

princess anne country club

Long considered to be one of the region's most beautiful and challenging par 70 tracts, the golf course at the Princess Anne Country Club was designed by Pete Dye protégé, Tim Liddy, to be a superb fusion of art and strategy for the novice and seasoned player. The course meanders through scenic neighborhoods lined by lush pines and crosses several inlets and lakes.
