Opportunity 1: South Florida PGA Foundation is offering an opportunity to individuals from diverse backgrounds to gain valuable insight into the administrative aspect of the golf business for a 9-month term (9 months will be spent with the South Florida PGA and 3 months will be spent with The Honda Classic).

MANAGER'S TITLE: Junior Golf Director (South Florida PGA) / Tournament Director (The Honda Classic)

JOB DESCRIPTION/DUTIES - South Florida PGA:

The primary focus of this position will be to assist South Florida PGA Foundation activities, including but not limited to, junior golf programming. Examples include:

- Assist with junior golf programming including all South Florida PGA Team Golf events, PGA Junior League activities, Drive, Chip and Putt Qualifiers, and the South Florida PGA Junior Prep, Challenge and Championship Tours
 - This would include the day-to-day operations of all junior golf programs, along with the onsite execution of the events
 - Assist in the planning, pairings, course marking, onsite administration, and pre and post event communications
- Assist with additional Foundation programming including but not limited to PGA HOPE, Smiling Fore
 Life and Habitat for Humanity
 - Assist with all communications for Foundation programming
 - Provide onsite support when needed
 - Assist with the tracking of all PGA Professionals who assist with Foundation programs

JOB DESCRIPTION/DUTIES – The Honda Classic:

- Assist in the following areas:
 - Provide support to the tournament staff in the development of grass roots advertising and promotions to impact the Honda Classic's brand awareness and increase individual and corporate ticket sales
 - o Provide extensive support to staff for all tournament special events.
 - Assist in the coordination and execution of all Family Day events
 - Communicate with the PGA Tour Child Care group to implement a successful player child care program
 - Provide support to Military Appreciation programs
 - Assist with sponsorship activation leading up to and during tournament time.
 - Provide creative and technical support for the ideation, design, production and distribution of assets for the tournament's advertising campaign
 - o Inventory and support the activation of promotional initiatives for the tournament
 - Assist with the development and deployment of onsite signage and branding
 - Monitor and update tournament website content, collaborate and assist with social media promotions and content postings







- o Prepare all deposits, post cash receipts, open mail and record checks in check log
- Handle the processing of daily credit card entries in AP and AR accounting for Birdies for Children
- Assist with volunteer mailings
- o Receive and process all volunteer applications
- Data entry into an access based database

- Knowledge of the golf industry, PGA of America and the PGA Tour
- Shows an interest in developing a career in golf

- Ability to work in a team environment and travel extensively

POSITION/PHYSICAL CONDITIONS:
